 4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
 5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
 6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

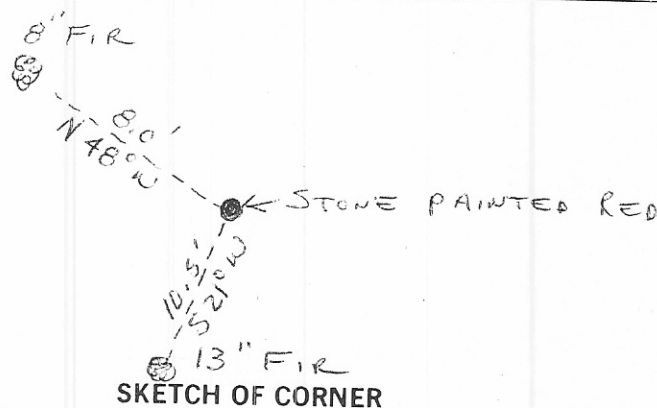
(Record) Stone 12x7x6 ins, 8 ins in ground with 1/4 on North face
 (Found) Stone with 1/4 on north face still well set

(Record) A pine 10" diam bears N66°W 106 lks. dist.
 (Found) Only rotten wood. no stump left.

(Record) A pine 16" diam. bears S74°W 73 lks. dist.
 (Found) Only rotten wood around. No stump left.

We left the stone in place as found and painted it red and marked the following R.M. trees.

8" diam Douglas fir bears N48°W 8.0 ft. dist.
 13" diam Douglas fir bears S21°W 10.5 ft. dist.
