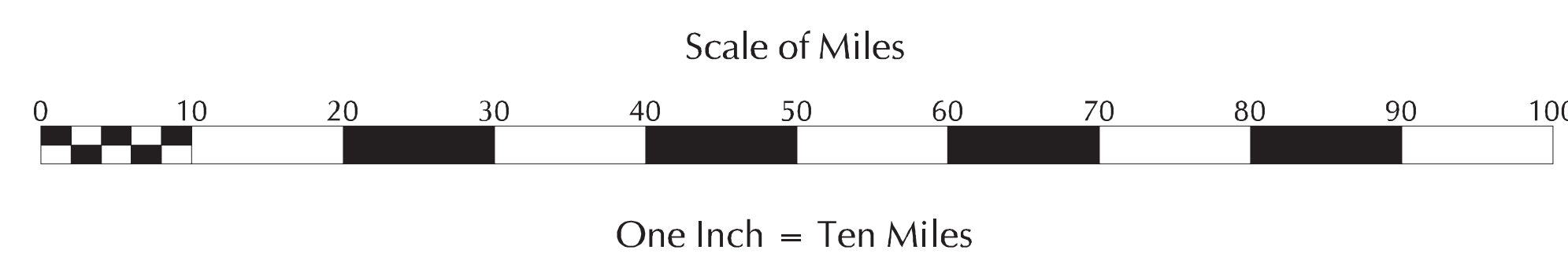

Additional information, corrections and updates (especially for tribal lands and private lands) were added by the University of Montana, Wildlife Spatial Analysis Unit, during 1996-1998. Since 1998, the MNHNP has made numerous updates and corrections (especially for Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks areas, US Fish & Wildlife Service areas, and preservation easements). These edits are based on data supplied by the various public agencies and land trusts, and have not been verified against county or Montana Department of Revenue records.
