SEPTEMBER 6, 1990 CONFERENCE THE PARTIES NOTED THAT THE CHANGED

FLOW RATE AND PRIORITY DATE REPRESENTED A NEGOTIATED

COMPROMISE, THAT THE PARTIES RELINQUISHED MORE SENIOR DECREED PRIORITY DATES AND GREATER FLOW RATES.
