More specifically, this tract is the northerly 147 feet of Tract C, Park County Amended Subdivision Plat No. 34 (SD 34).

The point of beginning is the northeast corner of said Tract C, which is N 28*39.8' E a distance of 2502.21 feet from the south 1/4 corner of

Section 26. The point of beginning is marked with a Surv Kap. Thence N 89*29.1' W along the northerly line of said Tract C, a
