ORIGINAL RECORD: (GLO - 1890, Page) Set a granite stone 12 x 8 x 6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on N. face, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E. and W. of stone, 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base alongside.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: No subsequent record.

EVIDENCE FOUND: (August, 2007) No original evidence was found. A North-South fence occupies the area.

PERPETUATION: (August, 2007) Held the North-South fence for Easting and the section line for Northing. Set a 5/8" rebar and 2" aluminum cap, marked as shown. Set a upside down steel "T" post, 0.3' North of the corner.
