Record: A post in a mound of earth with pits-charred stake as 1. per instructions.

2. No evidence of original corner found. Corner was established at proportional distance from a fence corner 2 miles south and 1 mile north for north-south position and in line with a fence which runs to the south for east-west position.

Set a #4x24" re-bar with yellow plastic cap (Duncan 4123-S) in 3. center of County road (buried approx. 4" under surface.
