

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner <u>to Secs 32 & 33</u> T. <u>5N</u> R. <u>11W</u> P.M.M. <u>Deer Lodge</u> County

1. Original Record (1876) - Set granite stone 14"x10"x5" - 9" in the ground. Marked ¼ on North face. Dug pits 18" square x 12" deep N, S, E & W 5.5' distance from corner.

Subsequent Record - Certificate of Survey 182A shows finding iron pin. Other Certificate of Surveys make calls to the corner but make no mention of what was found.

- 2. No evidence found of original or subsequent monuments. Re-established position from monuments found at the SW Cor. Tract A and the SE Cor. of Tract C of Certificate of Survey No. 41A. Used record ties to section line from C/S No. 41A and a tie from the centerline of the BA & P Railroad as called out in the deed granting ownership to BA&P Railroad (in book 30, page 315 Deer Lodge County Records). Deed shows a tie of 16.5' N. from centerline of tracts.
- 3. Set a 2" alum. pipe with a 3" alum. cap at the corner position. Set steel fence post with monument decal next to corner.
