A pine 5 ins. dia. bears S341/2°E, 114 lks. dist. marked T6N, R13W, S 8 B T. A pine 5 ins. dia. bears S52°W, 162 lks. dist. marked T 6 N R 13 W B T. A fir 5 ins. dia. bears N32°W, 68 lks. dist. marked T 6 N R 13W B T.

Found: I found a set stone with a mound of stone alongside. The stone was marked as described above, and had an iron pin drive alongside. The bearing tree in section 5 is standing. All other bearing trees are claimed by a logging operation.
