3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position

Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.

Certification must be signed and search by the sector of sheet.
Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

- 1904 GLO SURVEY "set a sandstone 18x12x5 ins RECORD: 12 ins in the ground for the cor to Secs 28,29 32 and 33 marked with 1 notch on the S and 4 notches on the E edges ..... "
- A stone as described above firmly set in place FOUND: 1 foot north of a barbed wire fence.
- A 5/8" X 24" rebar with a 1-1/2" aluminum cap SET: was set at the north edge of the found original stone monument as a witness. Bearing trees were established in each section as shown in sketch below.
