1904 GLO SURVEY - "set a sandstone 15X12X6 ins 10 ins RECORD: in the ground for the 1/4 cor to Secs 28 and 29 marked 1/4 on W face from which: A 24" pine bears S38°E a dist of 1.77chs marked 1/4 S 28 BT A 12" pine bears N54°W a dist of 94 lks marked 1/4 S 29 BT

- A 30" pine and a 16" pine both blazed and scribed FOUND: as described above. The original stone monument was not recovered.
- A 5/8" X 24" rebar with a 1-1/2" aluminum cap was set SET: at the record distance from the two found bearing trees.
