ORIGINAL RECORD: (Cumming, 1905) Set a sandstone 16 x 12 x 3 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for 1/4 section corner. Marked 1/4 on W. face from which pine 12 ins. diameter bears S50°E, 1.34 chs distance marked 1/4 S.11 B.T. Pine 24 ins. diameter bears S7°W, 1.17 chs distance marked 1/4S10 B.T.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: None

EVIDENCE FOUND: (March 2001) Found 11"x15"x3" sandstone firmly set in north-south direction with faint markings on the east face. Found original bearing tree to the southeast with original blaze and scribes, and found bearing tree stump to the west. Distances to bearing trees from stone were the same as the original stone.

PERPETUATION: (March 2001) Accepted stone as the original corner and replaced with 5/8" rebar with 2" aluminum cap. See drawing below.
