Resurvey of E. bdy. of T.6S., R.6E. - "North on E. bdy. of sec. 13... 80.00 Set a granite stone 20x16x5 ins. 15 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 12 and 13, mkd. with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edge, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor... ...[Set corner for secs. 7 and 18, T.6S., R7E.] 7.67 chs. (506.2 ft) N. of the cor of secs. 12 and 13, T6S, R.6E.

July, 1979: R. Allen, 4955S. Certified Corner Recordation filed with Park County Clerk and Recorder, Bk. 1, Pg. 14. "Found granite stone per record; no mounds; 4 notches on South and 2 on North...No accessories established at this time; stone in good condition."

September, 1979: R. Allen, 4955S. Certificate of Survey No. 415 filed with Park County Clerk and Recorder.

[Measurements given to adjacent corners along township line.]

2. August 29, 1995: Found corner stone, 15x12x5 ins., loose and lying on its side, with 4 distinct grooves on one side and 2 on the opposite side. The marked stone is surrounded by other scattered stones and is S.38<sup>o</sup>W., 8 ft. from a fence corner with fences extending N., S. and W. Survey ties to adjacent corners on the township line, indicate that the corner stone was removed from its original position when the fence corner was set.

The stone was found in its original position in 1979 by Ron Allen and survey ties are shown on Certificate of Survey No. 415. I accept the measurements shown on C/S 415 as the most reliable evidence of where the stone was originally located. I reestablish the corner for sections 12 and 13 by extending the section line from the E 1/4 of section 13 through the N 1/16 of section 18 and record distance from the N 1/16 (as shown on C/S 415). - 3. At the calculated corner position, set a 3/4 in. diam. by 24 in. long aluminum rod with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, 3 ins. out of the ground, marked as shown on front page. Bury the original stone west, alongside the new monument, and build a collar of stone, 2 ft. diam. by 6 ins. high.
  - From which, two reference monuments, both 2 in. diam. aluminum caps on 5/8 in. diam. rebar, flush with the ground, marked 'RM, T6S, R6E, S13, 1995' and an arrow with the distance to the corner: - RM 1 bears S. 7<sup>0</sup>41'14" W., 23.36 ft. dist. - RM 2 bears S. 84<sup>0</sup>26'14" W., 31.16 ft. dist.

The corner is 1/2 ft. north of the existing fence corner post, with open fields all around.
