They mark it "6-5917" for Corner No. 6 of this (MS 5917) survey; from which A Pine 6 ins. in diam., bears N05°W, 2.0 ft., mrkd "6-5917 BT". A Pine 6 ins. in diam., bears S47°W, 9.0 ft., mrkd "6-5917 BT". Found (3-23-2010): Found a firmly set 12" x 12" granite stone protruding 1.0 ft. out of the ground. The original stone was marked "4-3493" on the northwest face and had additional partially legible markings on the southeast face and an "X" on top; from which A 15" dead Lodgepole Pine, bears N05°W, 2.0 ft., mrkd "5917 4 3493 BT". A 12" dead Lodgepole Pine, bears S47°W, 10.0 ft., mrkd "5917 4 3493 BT". Due to the found monument being firmly set and in good condition we left it as found. Perpetuation (3-23-2010): We created the following reference monuments A 16" Douglas Fir, bears S72°E, 18.4 ft., blazed and scribed "S 2 BT". A 3-1/4" Aluminum Cap (Cor. No. 1 MS 5917), bears S10°30'07"W, 260.90 ft. Note: We set a 5 ft. red angle iron post with USFS decals P54-1 and P71-10, to the immediate southwest of the monument . We attach USFS signs 54-3 & 54-9, set a 60D spike at our spot of measurement and paint a 6" red band +/- 6 ft. above the ground on all reference monuments. Original stone was painted red. NAD83(CORS96): φ 46°23'22.77"N λ 112°34'41.72"W

**Note:** Coordinates were established by Real-Time Kinematic (RTK) GPS procedures utilizing Trimble R8 GNSS GPS receivers. Survey ties to controlling PLSS corners and local control points were measured from a base station constrained to the NAD83(CORS96) datum processed utilizing the National Geodetic Survey (NGS) Online Positioning User Service (OPUS) with observation data collected in March, 2010.
