## 1998 Remonumentation by S. R. Smith

I find no evidence of the original monument. Position falls in the center of a county road. At the intersection of the westerly extension of a fenceline running east with the apparent centerline of the county road running north-south, I set an aluminum pipe 2 1/2" diameter, 30" long, 34" in the ground, with 3 1/4" diameter aluminum cap, marked as shown below, from which,

- A 1.3" diameter brass disc, marked "SMITH 4740LS", set 2.2' above ground on the south side of a 10" diameter fence corner post with a Reference Marker tag, bears East, 28.74' dist.
- A 1.3" diameter brass disc, marked "SMITH 4740LS", set 1.44' above ground on the northeast side of a 8" diameter gate post with a Reference Marker tag, bears N 45° W, 41.44' dist.

Bearings listed in remonumentation section were measured with a hand compass, declination 14 1/2' East.
