
ORIGINAL RECORD: (Staffford, 1886) Set a sandstone 12x10x6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for corner to sections 9, 10, 15, and 16 marked with 3 notches E and 4 notches on S edges and raised a mound of stone alongside. From corner, set bearing trees.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: No corner forms of record but this corner is shown on an exhibit on the back of several corner forms show a found stone.

EVIDENCE FOUND: (August, 1998) Found a 14" x 9" x 7" sandstone with 4 notches on South and 3 notches on East edges, vertically set loosely in the ground.


PERPETUATION: (August, 1998) Replaced stone with 5/8" rebar with 2" aluminum cap marked as shown below. Laid original stone along the south side of the monument and set references as shown in drawing below.


