ORIGINAL RECORD: (GLO-Robinson, 1882) Set a sandstone, 14" x 9" x 7", 10 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs 1, 12, 6 and 7 marked 5 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the N. edges, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each section, 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2ft. high, 4 1/2 ft base alongside.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: (GLO-Stafford, 1886) For the Section Corner of Sections 6 & 7 a sandstone, 14 x 9 x 7 in. firmly set in the ground marked with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. edges with pits and mound of earth alongside bears North 3.60 chs from the corner of Sections 1 & 12.

EVIDENCE FOUND: (July, 2005) No original evidence was found.

PERPETUATION: (July, 2005) Set a 5/8" rebar and 2" aluminum cap, marked as shown at the single proportion position and set references as shown below.
