ORIGINAL RECORD: (Robinson, 1882) Set limestone 18"x 16"x 8", 12" in the ground for corner to Sections 20, 21, 28, and 29 marked 2 notches on South, and 4 on East edges, dug pits 18x18x12 in. in each section 5 1/2 ft. distant and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 1/2 ft. base alongside.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: None

EVIDENCE FOUND: (October, 1998) Nothing found due to farm activity.

PERPETUATION: (October, 1998) I perpetuated this corner at the best determined proportional position holding fences North and South and the Northeast corner of Section 20. No corners could be found up to 1 1/2 miles East of this corner. Nothing set at the corner position as it falls in a hay field. Set reference monuments, marked as shown. See drawing below.



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
