ORIGINAL RECORD: (GLO- G. Robinson, 1882) Point 75 ft. below. Set a Sandstone 14 x 9 x 5 ins., 9 ins. in the ground for the corner to Secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, marked 3 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the E. edges and raised a mound of stones covered with earth alongside.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: No subsequent record.

EVIDENCE FOUND: (May, 2005) No original evidence was found. A county road occupies the postion of the corner. It is apparent that the road bed has moved East and a larger barrow ditch has been constructed to account for drifting snow. The West R/W fence of this road is quite old and appears to be the original.

PERPETUATION: (May, 2005) Held 30' East of the old West R/W fence in line with an old fence to the West. At the determined position, set a ⁵/₈" rebar and 2" aluminum cap, marked as shown, 0.2 feet subsurface.
