- ORIGINAL RECORD: Set a sandstone 24 x 12 x 9 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Sec's. 7, 8, 17 and 18 marked 4 notches on S. and 5 on E. edges. Pits and mound of earth.
- 2. SUBSEQUENT RENCORD: Highway department map shows a position for the corner near the south right-of-way line but had no definite tie. found a set sandstone  $18 \times 9 \times 6$  ins. flush with the ground marked with 4 notches on the S. edge and E. edge was broken off. Top of stone may have been broken off some. Stone may not be the original but has been used as the True Corner for many years.

3. In place of stone I drove a  $5/8" \times 30"$  rebar 0.3 ft. above the ground and affixed a 2" dia. alum. cap stamped

and buried the found marked stone upside down along the east side of rebar.

The previous found 3/4" dia. pipe 10 ins. above ground bears  $589^{0}40'W.$ , 0.95 ft. A 4" x 4" conc. right-of-way marker at the top center-south edge bears  $588^{0}40'E.$ , 33.60 ft. A railroad spike 40.92 ft. N. of the right-of-way marker in the center of the highway bears N40<sup>0</sup>05'E, 52.54 ft. A fence Cor. post of fences E-W & S is 0.9 ft. W.S.W. Attached a survey monument sign to Cor. post.
