**SUBSEQUENT RECORD**: Nash (5210S) reported setting a rebar with aluminum cap on his C/S 321. He set the corner at a single proportion position. No corner record was filed.

**EVIDENCE FOUND:** (February, 2004) Found Nash 1 1/2" aluminum cap in small collar of stone 0.2' above ground. No additional accessories were found.

PERPETUATION: (February, 2004) Accepted Nash monument as corner. No additional accessories were set.
