Dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 in. deep E. and W. of stone 5 1/2 ft. distant and raised a mound of earth $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. high and $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. base alongside.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: None.

EVIDENCE FOUND: (May 1997) None.

PERPETUATION: (May 1997) Set 5/8" rebar with 2" aluminum cap at single proportion position. Raised collar of stone and set MARLS tag on a 6" diameter gate post and another on a 10" diameter fence corner post.
