ORIGINAL RECORD: (GLO-G. Robinson, 1883) Set a sandstone 18 x 14 x 6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, marked with 1 notch on S. and 2 notches on E. edges, dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each section 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth, 2 ft. high 4 1/2 ft. base alongside.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: (1993 & 1995, Nash) In Spenny Subdivision and in C/S 533, Nash states that he held a found 5/8" rebar with a Fletcher plastic cap. No corner form is filed.

EVIDENCE FOUND: (August, 2005) Found a 5/8" rebar with a yellow plasic cap at West base of a RR tie FCP.

PERPETUATION: (August, 2005)⁻ Accepted the 5/8" rebar with a yellow plastic cap. Set a MARLS tag on the RR tie FCP.
