CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner: West 1/4 Section 10 T. <u>16 N. R. 18 E.</u> P.M.M. Fergus County .

Original Record: (G. Robinson 1883) Set sandstone 12 x 7 x 7 inches, 8 inches in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W. face, dug pits 18, 18, 12 ins. N. & S. of stone 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base alongside.

Subsequent Record: County Road No. 229 and the abandoned Highway.

Evidence Found (March, 1997) None. Remains of the old county road and the old highway are apparent on the ground.

Perpetuation: (March, 1997) At the intersection of the old county road and a projected fence line from the east, set a 5/8" rebar with a 2" aluminum cap. See drawing below.
