## 2000 Remonumentation by S. R. Smith

I find a slate stone, 16x6x6 ins, marked with 5 notches on the south side and 4 notches on the east edge, as set by William K. Trippet. At the position marked by the found slate stone, I set a standard M.D.O.H monument, which consists of a 2¼ ins (5.715 cm) diameter, 30 ins (76.2 cm) long aluminum pipe with flared base and 3¼ ins (8.255 cm) diameter M.D.O.H aluminum cap, stamped as shown below. I bury the found stone monument upside—down below the newly set monument. Top of aluminum cap is level with ground. I place a stone collar around cap, from which:

A fir, 18 ins (45.72 cm) DBH, marked by Balstad, scribing overgrown, bears S72'E 38.66 ft (11.784 m) distant.

A larch, 9 ins (22.86 cm) DBH, marked by Balstad, scribing overgrown, bears N74°W 15.80 ft (4.816 m) distant.

## New references established this survey:

- A fir, 15 ins (38.1 cm) DBH, marked T22N R19W S4 BT, bears N64°E 41.25 ft (12.573 m) distant.
- A 3¼ ft (106.68 cm) long galvanized steel witness post with M.D.T survey decal attached, bears East 1.95 ft (58.5 cm).
- A fir, 13.5 ins (34.29 cm) DBH, marked T22N R19W S8 BT, bears S38W 6.25 ft (1.905 m) distant.

Bearings listed in remonumentation section were measured with a hand compass, declination 18°East.
