## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

Corner: NW Sec. 16 , T.47N., R57E., P.M.M., Roosevelt County

Original Record:

In 1946, for dependent resurvey, Emil Vought, G.L.O. Land Surveyor set an iron post 3' long, 2" diameter, with a brass cap.

Found:

In 2006, MDT Survey Crew 41–06 found monument, badly damaged but firmly set in the ground with brass cap cut off and placed next to iron post in ground. The found iron post was 61.8' East of centerline of Hwy. 250.

Set:

In 2006, reset damaged monument with standard MDT monument at same location 1.0' above ground and surrounded by large stones. Set witness post 1.0' East of monument. Set a 2" A.C. as a reference monument 120' West of corner with a witness post alongside. Used property corner pin as reference 18.36' to the East and set witness post alongside.
