



Distance east To the NE corner of Sec. 14 (a bronze cap 2 ft. west of the centerline of Old Highway 91) measures 5269.5 ft. which compares to GLO record of 5273.4 ft. This is accepted for the section corner.

MAINTENANCE: A cross was chiseled in the brass cap for a tie point. The monument is solid and requires no further work.
