The distance between WCMC Lt. and MC Rt. differs from the 1933 record by 18.2 ft. Assuming from the evidence that MS Rt. is as set, WCMC Lt. would have been below present high water and might have been washed out or moved and reset.

Therefore, using the nearest and best evidence, I determine the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner to be the 1914 record distance west of MC Rt. on a line between MC Rt. and WCMC Lt. (I accept WCMC Lt. as establishing the line only because it is within 02' of the section line east of MC Rt., and for the purposes of this survey (establishing longitude of E 1/16 cor. and C 1/4 cor.), this bearing is not crucial.

As the line between MC Rt. and the NE cor. of sec. 8 crosses the WC cairn (at which no specific point was originally set), I assume that the section line does not bend at the WC. Therefore the spike in the cairn is only a reference point.
